
The Value of Downtown: The Dollars & Sense of Development Patterns

Joe Minicozzi will discuss the value of downtown Main Street development and the implications of different growth patterns on public costs and revenues. He discusses methods such as property value analysis, tax studies, and revenue forecasting to help local officials understand the economics of different development patterns for cities, counties, and regions.

Joe Minicozzi is the Principal of Urban3, an Asheville, NC based urban planning consulting firm that uses economic data to visualize the implications of policy and community design. Urban3's pioneering work in geo-spatial representation of economic productivity has boosted the understanding the economic potency of downtown Main Streets and the value of well-designed cities. These methods simplify the presentation of complex information to include everyone in meaningful conversations about community growth. Joe is a sought-after lecturer on city planning issues, and his work has been featured in numerous journals. He holds a Master of Architecture and Urban Design from Harvard University.
