<p>2. Forest Pansy Redbud Brilliant scarlet-purple color to new foliage, maturing to maroon. Rosy-pink flowers in the Spring. <i>Height: 20' Spread: 25'</i></p>			
<p>3. Pink Dogwood Small deciduous tree. Splendid pink to red bracts followed in fall by hanging red fruit. Autumn leaves have red-scarlet tints. <i>Height: 20' Spread: 15'</i></p>			
<p>4. White Ash Beautiful fall color of deep red, maroon, purple or yellow. <i>Height: 40' Spread: 30'</i></p>			
<p>5. Fernleaf Beech A large growing tree with crisp, dark green, cutleaf foliage. <i>Height: 50' Spread: 40'</i></p>			
<p>6. Shumard Oak Majestic tree for large areas with russet-red fall color. <i>Height: 45' Spread: 40'</i></p>			
<p>7. Autumn Blaze Maple Brilliant, long lasting orange-red fall color with a uniform branching habit. <i>Height: 50' Spread: 40'</i></p>			
<p>8. Sugar Maple Mostly rounded, fast growing. Fall colors are yellow, orange and red. <i>Height: 50' Spread 35'</i></p>
