OBTAINING MORE INFORMATION: Copies of the application, all documents, and evidence submitted by or on behalf of the applicant and the applicable criteria are available for inspection at no cost at the Parks & Community Development Department. Copies may be obtained for a reasonable cost. The Parks & Community Development Department is located in Room 201 of the City of Grants Pass Municipal Building. A copy of the staff report will be available at least seven days prior to the hearing.

COMMENTING ON THE PROPOSAL: At the hearing, the Hearings Officer will take oral testimony concerning this proposal. Written testimony may be presented at the hearing, or may be submitted to the Parks & Community Development Department prior to the hearing. Prior to the close of the initial evidentiary hearing, any party may request an opportunity to present additional evidence or testimony regarding the proposal. The review body shall grant such request by continuing the public hearing or by leaving the record open for additional written evidence or testimony. Failure to raise an issue during the hearing, in person or by letter, or failure to provide statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes an appeal based on that issue.
