

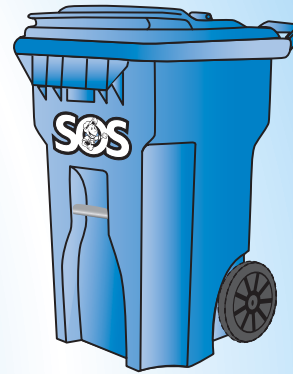

What About Recycling Used Motor Oil?

NOTE: Oil must be poured into non-breakable gallon containers with tight fitting screw caps (plastic gallon bleach or milk jugs work best). Place jugs NEXT TO your recycle cart.

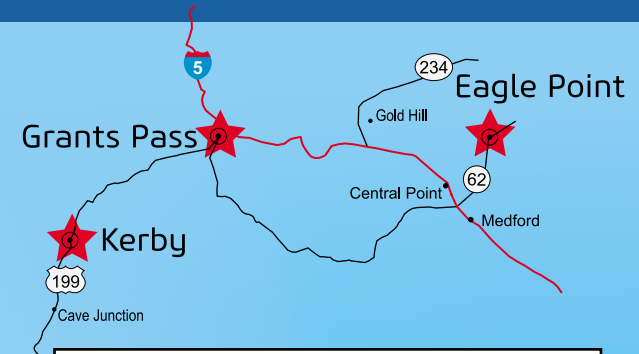

• Leave 5 feet between carts

• Do not bag recyclables

• No plastic or paper bags

• Place cart out when full

MILK JUG STYLE CONTAINERS

Clear or white. Rinse thoroughly - no lids



Quality over Quantity!

Follow our list of recyclables only, not the product label or recycling symbol.

Be vigilant in eliminating contamination from your cart.

Just toss the recyclable items in your cart, no bags please.

Reduce the materials you know cannot be recycled through our programs.

TIN CANS AND ALUMINUM CANS

Rinse thoroughly - no lids



The curbside recycling carts are loaned to our customers. If lost or stolen, you may be required to pay a deposit.
