



NOTICE OF HEARING GRANTS PASS CITY COUNCIL

Amendment to the City's CDBG Substantial Amendment of the 2019-2020 Year 5 AAP CARES Act COVID-19 Funding

Due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis, Congress passed legislation entitled *The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act* (CARES Act) March 27, 2020. One of the many parts of the CARES Act was to provide supplemental funds to CDBG grantees to help prevent, prepare for and respond to COVID-19. Additionally, the CARES Act provided CDBG grantees more flexibility thereby making it easier to use these additional funds expeditiously.

In May 2020, the City prepared and adopted a CDBG Substantial Amendment to its 2019-2020 Year 5 Annual Action Plan to allocate the City's first round of COVID-19 funds for activities related to COVID-19. The City has now received an additional round of CDBG COVID-19 funds to continue to help alleviate the ongoing effects of the coronavirus. The City will hold a public hearing on the date below to review the Amendment to the CDBG Substantial Amendment and hear public comment.
