## Rules

- Submit an original photo that demonstrates our theme of “Go with the Flow” to [whiggins@grantspassoregon.gov](mailto:whiggins@grantspassoregon.gov)
- Photos must be submitted in a digital format suitable for reproduction.
- Agreement Form must accompany each entry.
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, originality, and theme relevance.
- Entries become the property of the City of Grants Pass. The judges’ decision is final.
- Contest winners will be featured in the 2023 Water Quality Report, on social media, and in promotional activities.
- Entry deadline is 5 pm on December 15, 2023.
- Photos must be taken in Southern Oregon, specifically the following counties: Curry, Jackson, Josephine, and Klamath.

Employees of the City of Grants Pass and their family members are encouraged to submit photos but are not eligible for prizes.

## Terms and Conditions

Winners will be notified via email by January 12, 2024. The first-place entry will be featured in the 2023 Water Quality Report, on social media, and promotional activities.

Prizes are not re-assignable and non-transferable. No substitutions are allowed. Winners are responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes.
