MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS | Graduation from High School or GED and 1 year of work experience are required; or an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to perform the essential duties of the job, must be 21 years of age at time of hire, must meet physical standards as set by the Department of Public Safety on Standards and Training (DPSST), and must be a current certified Police Officer in Oregon or another state with reciprocity.
