MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS | Graduation from High School or GED and 1 year of work experience are required; or an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to perform the essential duties of the job, must be 21 years of age at time of hire, meet physical standards as set by the Department of Public Safety on Standards and Training (DPSST), have a valid driver's license with the ability to obtain an Oregon Class C License with 30 days of employment, DPSST Basic Police Certificate following completing of training (within 12 months of employment), and obtain the Law Enforcement Data System Certificate within 60 days of assignment.
